Getting here

Interstate attendees will need to make their own bookings for travel on the Spirit of Tasmania ferry crossing from Melbourne to Devonport. We regret that discount fares are not available unless a group of cars all travel on the same crossing, which we are unable to organise due to people arriving at different times.
